



## DERUMS PUTS RYCO HOSE ON POLE

Goulburn: Saturday, 31 March 2007

On a perfect autumn day in Goulburn – blue sky, mid-twenties, no wind – ‘Excalibur’ Derums achieved a career first by putting his Kanga Loaders Holden V8 Ute on pole position for tomorrow’s 11 lap Race 12 around this picturesque 2.2 km circuit

After a disappointing Round 1 of the Yokohama V8 Utes Series when he cooked an engine in Race 1, putting him out for the weekend and leaving him with zero points, Derums showed real speed a fortnight ago at Melbourne’s Australian Grand Prix meeting (a non-championship round), speed which he’s carried all this weekend.
